Building the North name 1902

By 1902 our membership was something of a 'who's who' of British Shipping; including Andrew Weir & Co, Ropners and Rundmans to name a few. It is no surprise that at this time we had become the leading P&I Club in the UK.



Pioneering new ways of working 1988

We began to pioneer new developments including our own Loss Prevention service which has since become the benchmark for all clubs followed by our own in-house FD&D service which still remains unique today.

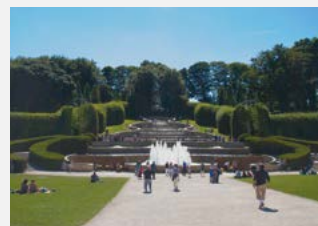
