Clean seas is North's loss prevention initiative to promote good practice and compliance with environmental legislation.

Clean seas can be achieved by following weather routing advice from approved sources. This should avoid weather that may put stress on hull, engine and cargo securing systems.

Clean seas can be achieved by operating an efficient vessel, saving on fuel, emissions and costs.

Clean seas and efficient running of a vessel can be helped by navigating with lights required by the COLREGS only.

Clean seas require ship operators to monitor the efficiency of their engines and control exhaust emissions in line with international and local legislation.

Clean seas and efficient running of vessels can be assisted by avoiding a build up of marine growth on the underwater section of hull.

Clean seas can only be achieved by adopting good working practices on board.
