Caring nurses inspire £5k donation to local Hospice

Tynedale Hospice at Home has received a £5,000 donation from maritime insurer The North of England P&I Association thanks to a staff member whose family experienced its nursing care services.

North P&I - who are based on The Quayside in Newcastle - has an active Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) programme and makes annual donations of around **£100,000** to worthwhile causes through a staff suggestion scheme. Staff nominate charitable organisations who are close to their hearts and often support such organisations year on year.

Mari Stewart, a projects and development executive at North P&I, nominated Tynedale Hospice at Home for a donation following her mum's experience of its nursing care services in 2016.

Mari said: "The reason I nominated Tynedale Hospice is really quite simple. Tynedale Hospice at Home enabled my Mum to die at home as she wished. She died in May 2016 of Acute Myeloid Leukaemia and in the last 24 hours of her amazing life the Hospice was there for her and our family. This enabled her to die in her own bed with my Dad at her side and the wonderful nurses managed her passing peacefully and with dignity. The kindness and professionalism of the nurses we met was overwhelming and they made this awful time more bearable.

"When it came to nominating a worthy cause - there was no doubt in my mind that Tynedale Hospice at Home would be my suggestion. They make such a difference to families who need hospice care and support."

It costs over £700,000 a year to run our services, of which 90% must be raised through voluntary giving and charitable donations.

“This donation will make a real difference to people who need our services - £20 will pay for an hour of nursing care, and a £5,000 donation could fund an amazing 250 hours of care.”

Tynedale Hospice at Home provides nursing care in the home, Family Support and Hospital Transport Services to people living in the areas of West Northumberland, Tynedale and Ponteland.
