


Safe Work

Restricted Visibility





Safe work is North of England's loss prevention initiative to promote good practice and safe systems of work on board ship.

Safe work is maintaining a proper lookout as the primary function of the bridge team.

Safe work means proceeding at a safe speed adapted to the prevailing circumstances and conditions of restricted visibility.

Safe work requires the use of hand steering in restricted visibility when appropriate.

Safe work means using electronic navigation techniques suitable for the prevailing circumstances and conditions.

Safe work means effective bridge team management to reduce the risk of an error by one person resulting in a dangerous situation.

Safe work practices will reduce the number of incidents and accidents.
